4. THE OBJECT for which the Charity is established is the education of the general public in the evolution of British Radar its operational use in World War II and subsequent developments

In furtherance of the said object but not otherwise the Trustees shall have the following powers:-

- (a) To increase the awareness knowledge and understanding of the general public concerning the research and development carried out on Radar and Electronics in Purbeck during World War II
- (b) To guide the general public in considering the major influence this work had on the successful outcome of the conflict and on subsequent developments in Radar and Electronics
- (c) To research collect record conserve and arrange information on the history development and uses of Radar and Electronics
- (d) To ensure that all such information is available for use in national and official archives
- (e) To establish a collection of suitable items relevant to the history development or use of Radar and Electronics
- (f) To establish and manage a Museum in which to display to the general public information and exhibits illustrating the history development and uses of Radar and Electronics
- (g) To provide facilities for study of and research into the history development and uses of Radar and Electronics
- (h) To co-operate to mutual advantage with other bodies involved in similar activities
